



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed improvements along FM 972 from I-35 frontage road to SH 95 in Williamson County, Texas. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 16, 2014, at the Walburg Community Center, 4000 FM 972, Walburg, TX 78673. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. with a brief presentation of the proposed project beginning at 6:00 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Meeting is to present the proposed project to the public, answer any questions, and receive comments. The proposed project would rehabilitate and widen existing pavement, add shoulders, and provide safety end treatments to fixed objects along FM 972. An urban section with sidewalks and curb and gutter drainage is also proposed through Walburg as part of the rehabilitation. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety along FM 972 by bringing it to current standards. The proposed improvements would require no new right-of-way (ROW). Maps showing the proposed project's location and geometric design will be available for viewing at the Public Meeting.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this public meeting and provide input on the project. A court reporter will be available to record verbal comments during the public meeting. Written comments may be provided at the meeting or submitted for a period of 10 calendar days following the meeting. Written comments must be received by December 26, 2014 to be included in the Public Meeting Summary.
