

**OPEN HOUSE NOTICE FOR THE
OAK HILL PARKWAY
U.S. HIGHWAY 290 (US 290) /STATE HIGHWAY 71 (SH 71) WEST
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT
FROM STATE LOOP 1 (MoPac) TO RANCH-to-MARKET (RM) 1826**

On May 23, 2013, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in cooperation with the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (Mobility Authority), will host an open house for the US 290/SH 71 West corridor between Mopac and RM 1826. The purpose of the open house is to review information provided by the public at the Oak Hill Parkway scoping meeting on November 15, 2012 and at subsequent workgroup meetings, discuss alternative concepts being developed based on public input, and gather additional public input on the project.

Website and/or mailed comments must be received by Monday, June 3, 2013.

The Public Meeting will utilize an open house, come-and-go format that will allow agency representatives and members of the public to review the materials at their convenience and speak individually to TxDOT, Mobility Authority and consultant staff.

A virtual open house will be active at www.OakHillParkway.com on May 23 with a live chat available on May 24 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and May 28 from 6-8 p.m.
