SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provision 006---030 (04), "Control of Materials"

The above referenced special provision has been approved for statewide use.

This special provision modifies Article 6.9, "Recycled Materials." This article currently has a requirement that all recycled materials must be documented on a signed and sealed certification. This is in conflict with DMS-11000. The new wording only requires that the material be used in accordance with DMS-11000, which describes the certification requirements.

This special provision also includes the requirements of 006---029 (04) which informs the Contractor that TxDOT will abate lead or asbestos separately from the prime contract.

This special provision replaces 006---029 (04) and is required on all projects beginning with the May 2007 letting. The use of this special provision prior to May 2007 letting is at the option of the district.

Please disseminate this information to your Transportation Planning & Development, Design, Construction, Maintenance, and Traffic Operations Engineers.
