**SUBJECT:** Statewide Special Specification 6629 (04), "Mobile Retroreflectivity Data Collection for Pavement Markings", Special Provision 6110--008 (04), "Reflectorized Pavement Markings with Retroreflective Requirements"; 6153--001 (04), "Multipolymer Pavement Markings (MPM) with Warranty"; 6154--002 (04), "Prefabricated Pavement Markings (PPM) with Warranty"; and 6473--001 (04), "Multipolymer Pavement Markings (MPM)"

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The above referenced special specification and special provisions have been approved for statewide use.

This special specification and special provisions implement a new qualification program for the mobile retroreflectometers. This special specification references the new qualification procedure. The special specification is needed to encourage more uniformity in the specifying process for these readings, to insure collection of accurate data and to obtain data in the format needed. The special provisions require the Contractor to furnish mobile retroreflectivity measurements in compliance with Special Specification 6629, "Mobile Retroreflectivity Data Collection for Pavement Markings".

These special provisions are required on all projects with Items 6110, 6153, 6154 and 6473 beginning with the June 2007 letting.

If special provisions 6110--008, 6153--001, 6154--002 or 6473--001 are used, then special specification 6629 is also required beginning with the June 2007 letting.

The use of this special specification or special provisions prior to the June 2007 letting is at the option of the district.
