**SUBJECT:** Statewide Special Provision 421---031 (04), "Hydraulic Cement Concrete"

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The above referenced special provision has been approved for statewide use.

This special provision adds modified Class F Fly Ash (MFFA) as an approved Supplementing Cementing Material (SCM), allows Tex-470-A, defines intermediate aggregate, modifies batching tolerances, restricts certain aggregate sources from Option 7 or Option 8, and removes the maximum number of evolutions.

This special provision replaces 421---024 and is required on all projects with Item 421 beginning with the May 2008 letting. The use of this special provision prior to May 2008 letting is at the option of the district.
