SPECIAL PROVISION AND/OR SPECIFICATION CHANGE MEMORANDUM 11-07

SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provisions 506---010 (04), 506---011 (04), 506---012 (04), and 506---013 (04), "Temporary Erosion, Sedimentation and Environmental Controls"

The above referenced special provisions have been approved for statewide use.

Special provision 506---010 (04) corrects an error for sand gradation for sandbags in Table 1. This special provision is required on all projects with Item 506 beginning with the September 2007 letting. The use of this special provision prior to the September 2007 letting is at the option of the district.

Special provision 506---011 (04) requires the Inspector to perform SW3P inspection every 7 calendar days and the Contractor to make corrections to control devices within 7 calendar days and includes the requirements of special provision 506---010.

Special provision 506---012 (04) requires the Inspector to perform SW3P inspection every 14 calendar days and after storm event of 0.5 inches and requires the Contractor to make corrections to control devices within 7 calendar days and includes the requirements of special provision 506---010.

Special provision 506---013 (04) requires the Inspector to perform SW3P inspection once a month and requires the Contractor to make corrections to control devices within 7 calendar days and includes the requirements of special provision 506---010.

Special provision 506---011, 506---012 or 506---013 can be used at the option of the district in place of 506---010. These special provisions replace 506---007, 506---008, and 506---009.
