SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provision 007---740 (04), "Legal Relations and Responsibilities"

The above-referenced special provision has been approved for statewide use and is required for all projects beginning with the September 2010 letting. This special provision replaces and incorporates the requirements of Special Provision 007-003, Special Provision 007-004, Special Provision 007-213, and Special Provision 007-639.

This special provision revises the second paragraph of Article 7.4 Insurance and Bonds to clarify insurance coverage must include the contracted work and the insurance must be maintained until final acceptance.

This special provision also revises Article 7.15. Electrical Requirements, Section A. Definitions, Section 3. Certified Person to extend the expiration date to January 1, 2011 for the TEEEX and TRF certifications. This extension will provide additional time for the development and piloting of new internet training modules currently being developed for TxDOT's I-Way system.
