SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provisions 000---4604 (93), "Disadvantaged Business Enterprise in Federal-Aid Construction"; 003---079 (93), "Award and Execution of Contract"; 009---099 (93), "Measurement and Payment"; 100---011 (93), "Preparing Right of Way"; 500---003 (93), "Mobilization"; 502---043 (93), "Barricades, Signs, and Traffic Handling"

The above referenced special provisions which address the DBE program changes have been approved for statewide use.

Special Provision 000---4604 (93) replaces 000---4072 (93) and is required on all federal aid projects beginning with the April 2006 letting.

Special Provision 003---079 (93) replaces 003---065 (93) on all federal aid projects beginning with the April 2006 letting. Special Provision 003---065 (93) will continue to be required on all non-federal-aid projects.

Special Provision 009---099 (93) replaces 009---062 (93) on all federal aid projects beginning with the April 2006 letting. Special Provision 009---062 (93) will continue to be required on all non-federal-aid projects.

Special Provision 100---011 (93) is required on all federal aid projects with Item 100, beginning with the April 2006 letting.

Special Provision 500---003 (93) is required on all federal aid projects with Item 500, beginning with the April 2006 letting.

Special Provision 502---043 (93) replaces 502---027 (93) on all federal aid projects with Item 502, beginning with the April 2006 letting. Special Provision 502---027 (93) will continue to be required on all non-federal-aid projects.
