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The above referenced special specifications have been approved for districtwide use in Abilene, Austin, Brownwood, Childress, Dallas, Fort Worth, Waco and Wichita Falls Districts.

These special specifications address responsibility for topsoil; identifies an additional compost manufactured topsoil category and requires the compost to come from the Bosque or Leon River Water Sheds.

Beginning with the August 2004 letting, these special specifications replace Special Specifications 1078 (93), 1025 (95) and 1000 (04); and special provision 1058--001 (93).
