SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provisions 000---1783 (95), "Disadvantaged Business Enterprise in Federal-Aid Construction"; 003---021 (95), "Award and Execution of Contract"; 009---051 (95), "Measurement and Payment"; 100---003 (95), "Preparing Right of Way"; 500---002 (95), "Mobilization"; 502---021 (95), "Barricades, Signs, and Traffic Handling"

The above referenced special provisions which address the DBE program changes have been approved for statewide use.

Special Provision 000---1783 (95) replaces 000---1720 (95) and is required on all federal aid projects beginning with the April 2006 letting.

Special Provision 003---021 (95) replaces 003---020 (95) on all federal aid projects beginning with the April 2006 letting. Special Provision 003---020 (95) will continue to be required on all non-federal-aid projects.

Special Provision 009---051 (95) replaces 009---045 (95) on all federal aid projects beginning with the April 2006 letting. Special Provision 009---045 (95) will continue to be required on all non-federal-aid projects.

Special Provision 100---003 (95) is required on all federal aid projects with Item 100, beginning with the April 2006 letting.

Special Provision 500---002 (95) is required on all federal aid projects with Item 500, beginning with the April 2006 letting.

Special Provision 502---021 (95) replaces 502---020 (95) on all federal aid projects with Item 502, beginning with the April 2006 letting. Special Provision 502---020 (95) will continue to be required on all non-federal-aid projects.
