SUBJECT: Statewide Special Specification 1122 (04) and Special Provision to
Special Specification 1122-001 (04), "Temporary Erosion, Sedimentation,
and Environmental Controls"

The above-referenced special specification and special provision have been approved for statewide use and are required for all projects beginning with the October 2012 letting. The above-listed special specification and special provision replace and incorporate requirements from Item 506 of the 2004 Standard Specifications, all Special Provisions to Item 506, and Special Specification 5049.

This special specification provides for storm water management, as outlined in the "Statewide Implementation of the Environmental Management System (EMS)" memorandum dated March 16, 2012, for the prevention or reduction of discharges in accordance with the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan and the Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit TXR150000.

In addition, the special specification identifies contractor-required training, the website address by which to obtain the training, fees associated with the training, requirements to designate a Contractor Responsible Person, and outlines responsibilities of implementation and maintenance activities required for compliance.
