**Subject:** Statewide Special Provision 007-011 (14), "Legal Relations and Responsibilities"

The above-referenced special provision has been approved for statewide use and is required for all projects beginning with the February 2021 letting. However, use of this special provision prior to the February 2021 letting is at the district's option.

This special provision replaces SP 007-001 and has replaced the first paragraph in the section for flaggers and added statement for the contractor to certify all flaggers will be trained and to make a list of certified flaggers available upon request. Changed the title of the Traffic Division to the Traffic Safety Division. The training section has been replaced with a reference to the Traffic Control Training MPL and the certification period has been changed from three years to four years. Additionally, the formatting has been changed for the section describing Optional Contractor-developed Training for Other Work Zone Personnel.
