SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provisions 003---026 (04), "Award and Execution of Contract; 009---012 (04), "Measurement and Payment"; 100---002 (04), "Preparing Right of Way"; 500---004 (04) Mobilization"; and 502---033 (04), "Barricades, Signs, and Traffic Handling"

These Special Provisions have been approved for statewide use by the Department's Specification Committee. These special provisions were created due to the passage of HB 2075 during the 80th Legislative Session and subsequent amendments to 43 TAC §9.20.

Special Provision 003---026 will replace SP 003---020 (federal-aid projects), and will be required on all construction projects (non-federal aid and federal-aid) beginning with the January 2008 letting.

Special Provision 009---012 will replace SP 009---008 and will be required on all non-federal aid projects beginning with the January 2008 letting.

Special Provision 100---002 replaces SP 100---001 (federal-aid projects), and will be required on all projects (non-federal aid and federal-aid) with Item 100, beginning with the January 2008 letting.

Special Provision 500---004 replaces SP 500---002 (federal-aid projects), and will be required on all projects (non-federal aid and federal-aid) with Item 500 beginning with the January 2008 letting.

Special Provision 502---033 replaces SP 502---022 (federal-aid projects), and will be required on all projects (non-federal aid and federal-aid) with Item 502 beginning with the January 2008 letting.

The use of these special provisions prior to the January 2008 letting is at the option of the district.
