The above-referenced special provision has been approved for statewide use and is required for all Federal Aided projects beginning with the November 2022 letting.

This Special Provision to Item 6 updates the Buy America Language to meet the requirements of the Build America Buy America Act included in the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. This is required by the Federal government on all Federal projects. Change ordering this SP into existing contracts is not required.

Additional documents which are introduced with this Special Provision include:

- 1) The "Buy America Material Classification Sheet" which aids in communicating which construction materials require certification.
- 2) Form 2806, "Construction Materials Buy America Certification" – form provided by the contractor certifying compliance with Buy America.
- 3) A required General Note – Guiding the contractor to the "Buy America Materials Classification Sheet" website as well as clarifying requirements.

This Special Provision also replaces Special Provision 006-001 for Federal Aided projects only. Special Provision 006-001 for Non-Federal Aided projects is still required.
