





Subject: Statewide Special Specification 6302 (14), "Temporary Queue Detection System"

The above-referenced special specification has been approved for statewide use and is optional for construction projects using temporary queue detection system beginning with the February 2019 letting. However, use of this special specification prior to the February 2019 letting is at the district's option.

This special specification provides for furnishing, installing relocating, operating, maintaining, and removing various components of an automated, portable, real time Temporary Queue Detection System as shown on the plans or as directed.

Temporary Queue Detection System standard sheets and a Smart Work Zone Guideline document are forthcoming soon from the Traffic Safety Division.
