Special provision 000---006 is required on all Federal-aid projects.

Special provision 000---007 is required on all Non-Federal-aid construction projects.

Special provision 000---008 is required on all Federal-aid except enhancement projects.

Special provision 000---009 is required for all Federal-aid construction projects.
