**SUBJECT:** Statewide Special Provision 6266--017 (04), "Video Imaging Detection System"

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The above-referenced special provision has been approved for statewide use. The use of this special provision is required for all projects using Item 6266, "Video Imaging Detection System," beginning with the October 2009 letting. This may be used at the district's option prior to October 2009.

Article 1. Description was revised to remove the requirement that a VIVDS configuration for a single intersection consist of 4 variable focal length cameras. The number of cameras is now unspecified.

Article 6. Camera Assembly, Section B. Camera and Lens Assembly was revised to change the enclosure temperature range from -30°F to +165°F to -30°F to +140°F.
