Special specification 6009 provides for furnishing, assembling, fabricating or installing ITS system support equipment.

Special specification 6010 provides for the materials, installation and testing procedures for communication cable.

Special specification 6011 provides for performing or furnishing testing, training, documentation, final acceptance and warranty on the applicable equipment or systems.
