SUBJECT: Statewide Special Provision 247---020 (04) and 247---021 (04),
"Flexible Base"

The above referenced special provisions have been approved for statewide use.

Special Provision 247---020 adds the maximum limit of 3000 ppm sulfates in recycled material when tested in accordance with Tex-145-E. This special provision is required on all projects with Item 247 beginning with the March 2007 letting. The use of this special provision prior to March 2007 letting is at the option of the district.

Special Provision 247---021 contains the requirements of 247---020 and 247---011. Special provision 247---021 replaces 247---011 and may be used in lieu of 247---020.
