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## Special Provision to Item 8

### Prosecution and Progress

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Item 8, "Prosecution and Progress" of the Standard Specifications is amended with respect to the clauses cited below. No other clauses or requirements of this Item are waived or changed.

**Article 8.1., "Prosecution of Work."** The first sentence of the first paragraph is voided and replaced by the following:

To accommodate the fabrication and delivery time required for traffic signal or illumination poles in addition to the Contractor's mobilization, other material production or acquisition, and general scheduling requirements; begin work within 120 calendar days after the date of authorization to begin work. Schedule a preconstruction meeting and provide a minimum seven calendar day written notice to the Engineer before beginning work.

**Article 8.3., "Computation of Contract Time for Completion."** The first paragraph is voided and replaced by what is noted below.

The number of working days is established by the contract. Working day charges will begin on the earliest date of the following:

- at 120 days after the date of authorization to begin work or
- when work begins.

Work must begin within 120 days after the date of authorization to begin work. No requests to delay the start of working day charges beyond 120 days will be granted. Working day charges will continue in accordance with the Contract.
