
Special Provision to Item 512

Portable Traffic Barrier



Item 512, "Portable Traffic Barrier" of the Standard Specifications is amended with respect to the clauses cited below. No other clauses or requirements of this Item are waived or changed.

Section 512.2.2, "Furnished by the Department" is supplemented by the following:

- 2.2.1. **Connection Hardware.** Provide connection hardware in accordance with the plan details conforming to the requirements of Item 442, "Metal for Structures." Connection hardware is defined as being sufficient hardware for one complete connection between two traffic-barrier sections, including the required bolts, nuts, washers, structural-steel shapes and dowels. Supply any additional connection hardware not Furnished by the Department (due to being either damaged or missing).

Article 512.5., "Payment." The first bullet of the first paragraph is voided and replaced by the following:

- For concrete barrier only, bid for "Portable Traffic Barrier" of the work category (Furnish and Install, Designated Source, Move, Stockpile, Remove, or Alternate Furnish), shape (e.g., Single Slope, F-Shape, or Low Profile) and Type (1, 2, 3, etc.) of barrier sections specified. This price includes equipment, labor, tools, incidentals, and all connection hardware.

Article 512.5., "Payment," is supplemented by the following:

- 5.6 **Alternate Furnish.** This price is full compensation for, at the sole choice of the Contractor, either furnishing and installing barrier sections and connection hardware OR delivering and installing Department-furnished barrier sections and connection hardware from a designated source. The Contractor may mix quantities of Contractor-furnished and Department-furnished barrier to achieve the required quantity, but no adjustment to the unit price will be allowed. Additional connection hardware not Furnished by the Department will not be paid for directly but will be subsidiary to the price bid per foot of barrier.
