

Special Specification 4166

Historic Marker



1. DESCRIPTION

This Item will govern for fabricating and installing a historic marker at the locations shown and in accordance with the details on the plans. The marker will consist of a plaque, vandal resistant mounting hardware, an erection post, and foundation.

2. MATERIALS

2.1.1. **Concrete.** Furnish class A or C concrete for post foundations in accordance with Item 420, "Concrete Substructures" and Item 421, "Hydraulic Cement Concrete."

2.1.1.1. **Hardware.** Furnish vandal resistant mounting hardware and erection post in accordance with Item 442, "Metal for Structures."

2.1.1.2. **Plaque.** Furnish an aluminum alloy plaque in accordance with the specifications shown on the plans. The plaque will be of the sizes and thickness shown on the plans. The plaque will contain a raised message as shown on the plans. The finish and color will be as shown on the plans.

3. CONSTRUCTION

3.1.1. **Foundation.** The foundation will be located as shown on the plans or as directed. All parts of the concrete foundations extending above the natural or finished ground line will be given an ordinary finish in accordance with Item 427, "Surface Finishes for Concrete." The plaque will not be attached to the erection post until the concrete has cured at least seven days.

3.1.1.1. **Hardware.** The vandal resistant mounting hardware and erection post will be in accordance with the details shown on the plans and will be painted with Protection System II, black in accordance with Item 446, "Field Cleaning and Painting Steel."

4. MEASUREMENT

Historic markers will be measured by each, complete in place.

5. PAYMENT

The work performed and materials furnished, in accordance with this Item and measures as provided under "Measurement," will be paid for at the unit price bid for "Historic Marker" as shown on the plans. This price will be full compensation for fabricating the plaque, for vandal resistant mounting hardware and erection post, for installation, for concrete and painting, and for all materials, labor and equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.
