Subject: Revised Roadway Standards

The following changes have been made to the roadway standard sheets.

The sheets will be applicable to all new construction projects beginning with April 2016 letting. The use of these sheets prior to that date is at the option of the district. The new standards are available from the Roadway Standards web page in Microstation®“dgn” and Adobe “pdf” format.

The following represents a summary of the individual sheet changes.

CSB(3)-16. The CSB(3)-16 is a replacement of CSB(3)-10. The sheet has been modified to show:

- General Note No.5 has been modified to specify the following: Anchor system shall be embedded 6” into fresh concrete or using a Type III, Class C Epoxy anchorage system.
- The detail for “Optional Anchorage” has been modified to include the note, “Fresh insertion method or Type III, Class C Epoxy Method.

SSCB(1)-16. The SSCB(1)-16 is a replacement of SSCB(1)-10. The sheet has been modified to show:

- General Note No.4 has been modified to specify the following: Anchor system shall be embedded 6” into fresh concrete or using a Type III, Class C Epoxy anchorage system.
- The detail for “Optional Anchorage” has been modified to include the note, “Fresh insertion method or Type III, Class C Epoxy Method.
