SUBJECT: Delineator & Object Marker Installation and
Material Description Standard Sheet – D&OM(1)-10

To promote cost savings, the Administration has directed the General Services, Construction and Traffic Operations Divisions to evaluate traffic products to ensure competition exists to provide lower costs to the state. As a result of this, the Traffic Operations Division has revised the Delineator & Object Marker Installation and Material Description Standard Sheet (D&OM(1)-10) to be consistent with the updated Departmental Material Specification for Flexible Delineator and Object Marker Posts (DMS-4400). The revised sheet should be used starting with the October 2010 letting.

A summary of the standard sheet revisions are listed below:

- Two product-specific post installation details have been removed and replaced with a figure showing examples of approved posts for delineators and object markers using the terms “embedded” and “surface mount”.
- The following changes have been made to the D&OM Descriptive Codes in the lower left corner of the standard sheet:
 - The term “RCR = Recycled Rubber” has been removed and is combined with “FLX = Flexible Post”.
 - The term “GND = Ground Mount” has been renamed “Embedded (drivable or set in concrete)”;
 - The term “SLF = Self Righting Surface Mount” has been removed and is combined with “SRF = Surface Mount”; and
 - The terms “WP = Wedge Anchor Plastic” and “WS = Wedge Anchor Steel” have been removed and are combined with “GND = Embedded”
