Subject: Traffic Standards Compatible in both SS10 Environment and Connect Edition

The Traffic Standards DGN files have been updated to be compatible in both the SS10 environment, and the Connect Edition (Bentley Apps). There are no new differences in the actual appearance, and depictions of the standards; they are simply now compatible for either platform and are available for immediate use as needed. The standards are available from the Traffic Standards web page in Microstation®“dgn” and Adobe “pdf” format:

Please distribute this information to the appropriate district staff and area offices, as well as consulting engineers working on TxDOT projects.

This update will facilitate the continued migration to the Connect Edition (Bentley Apps) platform and models, as well as provide compatibility for those projects that are still being done in the SS10 environment. As communicated in a [March 23, 2022 memo](#) from Design Division, all designers are expected to use the Connect Edition platform for all projects that began after June 1, 2022.
