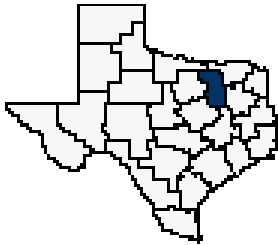




DISTRICT PROFILE

The Dallas District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in seven counties, ranging from major urban areas to suburban and rural locations. The district awards dozens of construction and maintenance contracts annually to improve safety, enhance mobility and preserve the existing highway system. The Dallas District also experiences sub-freezing temperatures, winter weather events and other emergencies that require full mobilization of assets and crews to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

KEY PROJECTS UNDER WAY:

- **U.S. Highway 175 (S.M. Wright):** Phase II and IIB: Demo existing highway and rebuild as parkway- \$78.7 million.
- **Lowest Stemmons:** I-35E from I-30 to Oaklawn Avenue: Construct new direct connect ramps and improve frontage roads - \$79 million.
- **Southern Gateway:** Rebuild/widen existing I-35E from Colorado Boulevard to Ann Arbor Avenue and widen US 67 from I-35E split to I-20 - \$666 million.
- **635 East:** I-635 from US 75 to south of I-30; add one general purpose lane, one grandfathered managed lane and continuous frontage roads in each direction - \$1.74 billion.
- **Irving Interchange:** Reconstruct the interchanges at SH 183, SH 114, SL 12 & Spur 482-\$301 million.

PLANNED KEY PROJECTS:

- **I-35 Denton County Connections:** Reconstruct interchanges and frontage roads; improve the Y-connection at I-35E/I-35W; reconstruct and widen I-35 between US 77 to Cooke County line. Phased construction beginning 2022 - \$1.5 billion.
- **I-30 From Bass Pro Drive to Hunt County Line:** Reconstruct and widen I-30 and add continuous frontage roads, including across Lake Ray Hubbard. **Segment 1** from Bass Pro Drive to Dalrock Road: Add continuous frontage roads, letting spring 2021. **Segment 2** Dalrock Road to SH 205: Add continuous frontage roads, letting fall 2022. **Segment 3** from SH 205 to Hunt County line: Reconstruct and widen I-30 from 4 to 6 lanes and reconstruct frontage roads, letting fall 2022. - Total project cost - \$771 million.
- **Loop 9 Corridor B:** Phased construction of frontage roads from I-35E to I-45, letting in fall 2022 - \$133 million.

MAINTENANCE: The Dallas District contracts out the majority of its maintenance work, an effort that totaled \$83 million in FY 2020. The District also performed \$26 million in in-house maintenance in the same year.

CORRIDORS: The Dallas District features multiple major interstates (I-20, I-30, I-45, I-35E, I-345 and I-635), US highways (75, 380, 175) and state highway corridors. It also boasts 6,159 on-system and off-system bridges in the seven-county area.

SAFETY: The Dallas District had the second lowest average fatality rate based on vehicle miles traveled for the year 2019. (0.99 fatalities for every 100 million miles traveled.)
