The Public Meeting will be conducted in an open house format. TxDOT staff will be available to answer questions. All material will be presented in English and Spanish. No formal presentation will be given. Parking will be available on the street and in nearby parking lots.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about the proposed project and gather input from the public.



The proposed I-10 project is the construction of Collector-Distributor (C-D) lanes and improvements to the interchange at US 85. The proposed total project length is approximately 5.75 miles between SH 20 (Mesa Street) and Executive Center Boulevard. These improvements will minimize weaving movements and increase safety on the I-10 main lanes and interchanges. D lanes will be constructed to the outside edge of the existing main lanes in both east and west directions connecting three interchanges. The existing direct connector at Resler Drive and the direct connector at Sunland Park Drive will be replaced with improved connectors. improvements are also proposed for the existing interchange at Mesa Street, Sunland Park Drive and Executive Center Boulevard. Most of the proposed improvements will be completed within

the existing right-of-way; however, approximately 2 acres of additional right-of-way will be required for the project in commercial and undeveloped areas with no displacement of residences or commercial structures.
