



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

FM 157 (COOPER STREET) from Mitchell Street to Arkansas Lane in Arlington, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of Arlington will be holding an open house public meeting on Tuesday, January 10, 2012. This meeting will be on a come and go basis between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in the Arlington City Hall Council Briefing Room, located at 101 W. Abrams Street, Arlington, Texas. There will be no formal presentation. The purpose of the meeting is to offer an opportunity to discuss and make comments on the proposed improvements to FM 157 from Mitchell Street to Arkansas Lane.

This proposed project includes removing and replacing the aging roadway surface and improving safety by constructing a raised center median in place of the two way continuous left turn lane. These improvements will begin at Mitchell Street and end at Arkansas Lane.

Maps, drawings, and other information about the project will be on display, showing location of the project and the proposed route. Project personnel will be on hand at the displays throughout the hours of the open house. They will assist in orientation and interpretation of the drawings and other material on hand, and will be available to discuss possible design and environmental effects of the project.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this public meeting. Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and will become part of the project documentation.
