

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

FM 3391 (East Renfro Street) from I-35W to East of CR 602

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house public meeting to discuss improvements to Farm-to-Market (FM) 3391 (East Renfro Street) in Burleson (Johnson County). The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 7th, 2016 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Stribling Elementary (Cafeteria) located at 1881 E. Renfro Street in Burleson, Texas.

The proposed project would widen, reconstruct and upgrade FM 3391 from Interstate 35W (I-35W) to east of County Road (CR) 602. The proposed construction limits would extend from existing northbound frontage road of I-35W to approximately 1,490 feet east of CR 602. The existing FM 3391 between I-35W and South Hurst Road would be improved from a five-lane undivided section to six-lane divided section, and from a two-lane undivided section to four-lane divided section between South Hurst Road to east of CR 602.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide a forum for exchange of information to help create a balanced design. Maps, drawings, and other information about the project will be on display. Members of the project team will be available to answer questions during the meeting. No formal presentation will be provided.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this meeting to view the displays and provide the project team with comments. Written comments may be presented either at the meeting or may be mailed to TxDOT so they may be incorporated in the public meeting record. Written comments may be submitted to:
