



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING IH 30 INTERCHANGE AT WALSH RANCH PARKWAY

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a Public Meeting to discuss the proposed IH 30 Interchange at Walsh Ranch Parkway in the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant and Parker Counties, Texas. There will be no formal presentation. The Public Meeting will be an open house format held on:

The proposed improvement is a new interchange with IH 30 (bridges and ramps) at the proposed Walsh Ranch Parkway. The proposed interchange would provide access to the future Walsh Ranch mixed-use development from the existing freeway system.

The proposed project is needed to improve traffic circulation and safety in support of economic development in the area. The purpose of the project is to provide access between the interstate system and the Walsh Ranch development. The proposed project would support expected land use development by helping improve mobility, enhancing access, reducing congestion, and improving safety along the IH 30 corridor. The proposed project also improves safety and circulation in the surrounding area by allowing for continuous one-way frontage road operation along IH 30 east and west of the project area.

Maps and drawings reflecting the proposed Build Alternative will be displayed at the Public Meeting. This and other information about the proposed project are available for public inspection at the TxDOT Weatherford Area Office, 1427 W. Bankhead, Weatherford, TX 76086.
