



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

US 377 at East Belknap Street in Haltom City, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of Haltom City will be hosting an open house public meeting on August 16, 2012. This meeting will be on a come and go basis between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Haltom City Civic Center, located at 3201 Friendly Lane in Haltom City, Texas. There will be no formal presentation. The purpose of the meeting is to offer an opportunity for the public to discuss and make comments on the intersection improvements to US 377 at East Belknap Street.

This project will realign US 377 (Denton Highway) to intersect Belknap approximately 500 feet northeast of the existing signal. The new signal will have a fourth leg that will provide a connection to Highland Avenue. The new signalized intersection will have a dual right turn movement from northeast bound Belknap to northbound Denton Highway. The existing Highland Avenue tie into Belknap will change from signal controlled to stop controlled with the through movements along Belknap operating freely.

Maps, drawings, and other information about the project will be on display, showing location of the project and the proposed route. Project personnel will be on hand at the displays throughout the hours of the open house. They will assist in orientation and interpretation of the drawings and other material on hand, and discuss possible design and environmental effects of the project.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this public meeting. Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and will become part of the project documentation.
