



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING US 377 CRESSON MOBILITY PROJECT

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a Public Meeting to discuss the proposed US 377 Cresson Mobility Project in the City of Cresson, Hood and Johnson Counties, Texas. The Public Meeting will be an open house format held on:

A previous Public Meeting was held on May 13, 2010 to discuss the six alternatives (including the No Build Alternative) associated with the US 377 Cresson Mobility Project. Based on public and agency input, Alternative B1, the westernmost build alternative, was carried forward for further study along with the No Build Alternative. Since that time, refinements have been made to the Build Alternative design. TxDOT will display the refined alternative to the public and request feedback during the open house Public Meeting.

The proposed project is needed because the proximity of the FW&WR at-grade railroad crossing on US 377 to the SH 171 intersection impedes traffic flow; high levels of truck traffic lead to congestion along US 377; short-term solutions will not provide extended relief for motorists; and, US 377 is part of the Texas Trunk System. The purpose of the proposed project is to provide a long-term solution to identified traffic issues at the US 377 and SH 171 intersection.

Maps and drawings reflecting the proposed Build Alternative will be displayed at the Public Meeting. This and other information about the proposed project are available for public inspection at the TxDOT Stephenville Area Office, 2281 E. Washington, Stephenville, TX 76401.

All interested persons are invited to attend this Public Meeting. Persons interested in attending the Public Meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact TxDOT at (254) 965-3511 at least three (3) work days prior to the Public Meeting. Requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least three work days prior to the Public Meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
