


Project Location Map

Project Description

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Houston District, proposes to reconstruct the US 59 South/IH 610 West Interchange in Harris County, Texas. The proposed roadway improvement project would construct new direct connectors, construct access ramps, adjust Post Oak Boulevard, and reconstruct the IH 610 main lane bridge. Project construction would be phased and the timing of construction would depend on the availability of funds. Minor amounts of additional right-of-way would be required for the proposed project. The additional right-of-way would be obtained from private property. One business relocation would be required as part of the proposed project. The proposed project construction is anticipated to begin in 2013.

Purpose of Proposed Project

The project improvements are proposed to increase safety, reduce congestion, and improve operational efficiency,
