



Public Meeting Notice
Farm to Market Road 518
State Highway 288 to State Highway 35
Brazoria County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting to provide information about the proposed widening of Farm to Market Road (FM) 518 from State Highway (SH) 288 to SH 35 for a length of approximately six (6) miles in Brazoria County, Texas.

The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 14, 2015, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Jamison Junior High School located at 2506 Woody Road, Pearland, TX. The meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will include display exhibits, schematic, and other information related to the proposed project in an open house format. There will be no formal presentation.

The proposed project consists of widening FM 518 from the existing four-lane facility to a six-lane urban section with a raised median. The project would potentially require additional Right-of-Way (ROW) and/or relocations. Specific ROW requirements and associated impacts, if any, will be determined during the subsequent alternatives development and schematic design process.

The public meeting will provide an opportunity to submit written comments. Written comments may be submitted in person at the public meeting, or by mail to TxDOT Houston District, Attn: Director of Project Development, P.O. All comments must be submitted within ten (10) working days after the public meeting (**postmarked on or before May 28, 2015**).
