



### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 528 Extension Project  
From: State Highway (SH) 35B (Gordon Street) to SH 6  
Brazoria County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of Alvin will conduct a Public Hearing regarding the proposed extension of FM 528 from SH 35B (Gordon Street) to SH 6. The Public Hearing details are as follows:

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to gather input from the public on the preferred alternative for the proposed extension of FM 528, in the City of Alvin, Texas. The existing FM 528 roadway, adjacent to the project limits, is a two-lane undivided facility. The proposed project would consist of a two-lane undivided facility, partially on new location, with a grade separation over the existing Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Railway, and new signalized intersections at SH 35B (Gordon Street) and SH 6. The proposed project is approximately 0.90-mile in length.

The preliminary diagrammatic design showing the proposed alternatives, including the preferred alternative, is on file and available for inspection at the City of Alvin Public Services Facility located at 1100 W. Highway 6, Alvin, Texas 77511, TxDOT Houston District office located at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007, and the TxDOT Brazoria Area Office located at 1033 East Orange Street, Angleton, Texas 77515. The City of Alvin offices are open Monday through Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., excluding some State holidays. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding State holidays.

Additional right-of-way would be required for the proposed project. Personnel from the TxDOT Right-of-Way Section and the City of Alvin will be available to discuss TxDOT's Relocation Assistance Program that provides benefits and services for those that may be displaced, as well as other right-of-way concerns. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve traffic operations, travel times, increase emergency access, and reduce traffic delay along a congested and developing FM 528 corridor.

All interested persons are invited to attend the Public Hearing. Persons interested in attending who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the TxDOT District Public Information Officer at (713) 802-5072 at least two working days prior to the Public Hearing. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding state holidays. The Public Hearing will be conducted in English. Any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should be made at least two working days prior to the Public Hearing. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.

Oral and written comments about this project may be presented at the Public Hearing. Written and oral comments will be considered equally. Written comments may be submitted in person at the Public Hearing or by mail to TxDOT Houston District, Attention: Director of Project Development, P.O. Box 1386, Houston, TX 77251-1386.
