Project Need and Purpose

Project Needs

- High Level of Congestion (One of the most Congested Highways in Texas)
- Lack of Mobility
- Inefficient Operations
- Safety

Project Purpose

The purpose of the proposed IH 610 West Loop express lanes is to decrease traffic congestion, increase mobility, and improve operational efficiency and safety along IH 610 West Loop within the Uptown/Galleria area of the City of Houston.



Project Description

Construct elevated express lanes primarily down the center of IH 610 West Loop mainlanes from IH 10 West to IH 69 (US 59) South (approximately 3.8 miles). The express lanes may be tolled.

The proposed elevated express lanes would be constructed within the existing right-of-way.




Project Schedule and Cost
