



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

### **Red Bluff Road from Kirby Boulevard to State Highway 146**

Harris County Engineering Department (HCED) and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed bridge construction, paving improvements, and drainage improvements to Red Bluff Road from Kirby Boulevard to State Highway 146 in the City of Seabrook, Harris County, Texas. The public meeting will be held on Thursday, December 15, 2016, at the Seabrook Intermediate School located at 2401 North Meyer Road, Seabrook, Texas 77586. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. **No formal presentation will be made.**

The proposed project would construct two new eastbound lanes and convert the existing roadway to westbound lanes separated by a raised median. It would also include the addition of a new bridge parallel to the existing Taylor Lake Bridge. The existing bridge includes a two-lane, undivided roadway without pedestrian walkway facilities. This existing bridge, located north of the proposed new bridge, would be improved to safely facilitate three lanes of westbound traffic. The proposed new bridge would include two lanes of eastbound traffic and a 10-foot-wide shared-use trail.

The proposed project area includes 1.5 miles of roadway. An additional 0.3 acres of right-of-way (ROW) would be required for the additional pavement width of the proposed project; however, no displacement of local residents is expected. Exhibits showing aerial photography and schematic plans of the proposed project corridor will be present at the meeting. Representatives from the HCED, TxDOT, and their study team will be available to answer individual questions. Public comments are encouraged.

All interested citizens are invited to attend, to express their views, and discuss the project with HCED and TxDOT representatives. The public meeting will be conducted in English. Those interested in attending who have special communications or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the TxDOT Houston District Public Information Officer at (713) 802-5076 at least five working days prior to the date of the meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding state holidays.
