CAMBRIDGE STREET EXTENSION

PUBLIC MEETING – MARCH 19, 2013

The Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) will conduct a public meeting to present proposed roadway improvements over IH 610 and along Cambridge Street in Houston, Harris County, Texas. The meeting will be held on March 19, 2013, in the Shearn Elementary School Cafeteria at 9802 Stella Link, Houston, Texas 77025. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the proposed roadway improvement project. The proposed project would construct a new bridge connection between Cambridge Street north of IH 610 to the eastbound frontage road south of IH 610 and would include widening existing Cambridge Street from the northbound IH 610 frontage road to Holly Hall Street. Approximately 3 acres of additional right-of-way would be needed for the proposed improvements. The project length is approximately 0.25 mile.

Exhibits showing aerial photography and schematic plans of the proposed project corridor will be presented at the meeting. Representatives from TXDOT and their study team will be available to answer individual questions. Public comments are encouraged. The schematic plan is on file and available for review at the TXDOT Houston District Office at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007. TXDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, excluding state holidays.

All interested persons are invited to attend this public meeting. Persons interested in attending the public meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the TXDOT Public Information Office at 713-802-5072 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Since the public meeting will be conducted in English, any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two working days prior to the public meeting. TXDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
