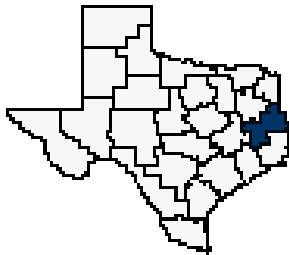




DISTRICT PROFILE

The Lufkin District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its nine counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and hazard elimination projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

KEY PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- **US 59/Loop 224 South (Nacogdoches Co.):** Construct US 59 direct connectors, overpass at Spradley Street and frontage roads along SL 224 from SH 7 to BU 59 - \$86.2M
- **US 69 Trunk System (Angelina Co.):** Widen to a 4-lane divided highway (FM 1270 to Jasper County line) - \$37.4M
- **US 69 Trunk System (Angelina Co.):** Widen to a 4-lane divided highway (FM 844 to FM 1270) - \$71.6M
- **US 59 Diboll Relief Route (Angelina Co.):** Construct new location freeway - \$140.9M
- **US 59 Moffett to SH 103 (Angelina Co.):** Construct frontage roads and widen mainlane bridge from Moffett Road to SH 103 - \$19.3M

PLANNED KEY PROJECTS:

- **US 59 Redland Upgrade (Angelina Co.):** Construct frontage roads from north SL 287 to FM 2021 - \$52.5M
- **US 59 Shepherd to Cleveland Upgrade (San Jacinto Co. and Liberty Co.):** Construct frontage roads from FM 2914 to 0.65 mi south of SL 573 - \$116 million
- **US 59 Corrigan Relief Route (Polk Co.):** Construct new location freeway - \$171.5 million
- **US 59/US 259 North (Nacogdoches Co.):** Construct interchange and frontage roads from FM 343 to just north of US 59/US 259 intersection - \$108M
- **US 59 Shepherd to Trinity River (San Jacinto Co.):** Construct frontage roads from FM 223 to Trinity River - \$213M
- **US 259 Center Turn Lane (Nacogdoches Co.):** Widen roadway to provide two-way center turn lane from SH 204 to Rusk County Line - \$32.3M
- **US 96 Super 2 (Sabine Co.):** Widen road to add passing lanes from FM 83 to Spur 414- \$6.9M
- **US 190 Center Turn Lane (Polk Co.):** Widen road to provide two-way center turn lane from Livingston to 4 mi west of FM 1276- \$29M

MAINTENANCE: The Lufkin District spends approximately \$9.5 million annually on seal coat projects. It will spend several million in FY 2021 rehabilitating roadways throughout the district.
CONSTRUCTION: In FY 2021, the district will let more than \$112 million on construction projects including: bridge replacements, overlays, sidewalks, road rehabilitating and widening, etc.
CORRIDORS: The Lufkin District's priority corridor effort is the development of I-69 along US 59 and US 84 and Super 2 improvements along US 96 and US 190.
