| 2020               | Beaumont       | \$ 1,570,019               | Construction of an illuminated truck queuing area at the corner of Emmett Ave. and Pennsylvania Ave.  |
| 2020               | Corpus Christi | \$ 3,763,988               | Expansion of Rincon Road by 3,400 linear feet to include intellegent transportation system components, lighting, striping, signal incstallation and improvement of the intersection.  |
| 2020               | Harlingen      | \$ 5,262,841               | Construction of a queuing area and expansion of Robles Road by 2,200 linear feet from FM 1846 to Arroyo Colorado.   |
| 2020               | Houston        | \$ 1,116,637               | Construction of 9,400 linear feet of a five-lane divided roadway with a two-way turn lane from Market Street to Jacintoport Blvd.   |
| 2020               | Mansfield      | \$ 2,919,107               | Phase 1 of a two phase project to construct a queuing area on port-owned land near SH 186 for container-on-barge service.   |
| 2020               | Port Arthur    | \$ 1,497,386               | Construction of two truck queuing areas; project is divided into two parts.   |
| 2020               | Victoria       | \$ 1,431,101               | Construction of queuing lanes on Weaver Road and a right turn lane with illumination on FM 1432.  |
| 2020               | West Calhoun   | \$ 2,437,450               | Expansion of Long Mott Access Road to two lane paved roadway.   |
| 2021               | Calhoun        | \$ 1,999,510               | Improvements to FM 1593   |
| 2021               | Corpus Christi | \$ 2,958,867               | Phase 2 of a two-part capacity project on the Joe Fulton ITC that will add a secondary access point and will include intelligent transportation system components, lighting, signage, and drainage and stormwater components. |
| 2021               | Freeport       | \$ 8,718,537               | Widening of SH 36 from two-lane to four-lane divided roadway from Brazos River Bridge to FM 1495.   |
| 2021               | Galveston      | \$ 3,750,000               | Construction of a new Cruise Corridor and three four-lane access roads from SH 275 to the corridor.   |
| 2021               | Palacios       | \$ 1,698,910               | Construction of a box culvert and drainage improvements at SH 35 and 12th Street  |
| 2021               | Sabine Pass    | \$ 874,177                 | Resconstruction of First Ave. from Broadway Ave. to the port entrance.  |
