As part of the development of the Statewide Long-Range Transportation Plan 2035, TxDOT is hosting two rounds of [public meetings](#). TxDOT held the first round of these public meetings in May of 2010. A [questionnaire](#) was administered to help gain insight and information about the transportation system. This questionnaire elicited information regarding:

- How you commute to work/school (mode)
- Other means of travel in Texas
- Rating of the transportation problems in Texas
- Potential solutions for improving Texas roads and improving public transportation
- Potential solutions for improving travel between Texas cities

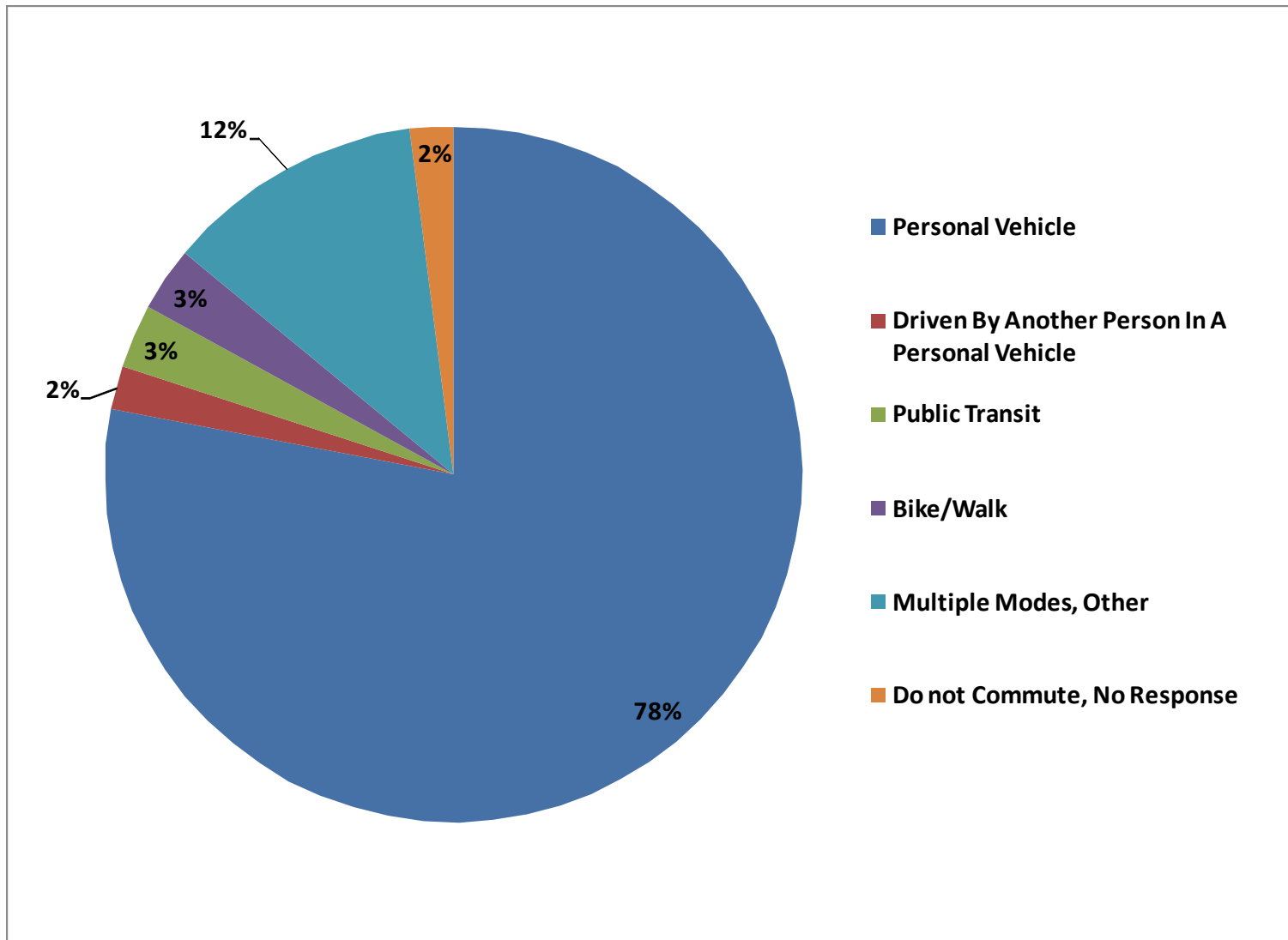

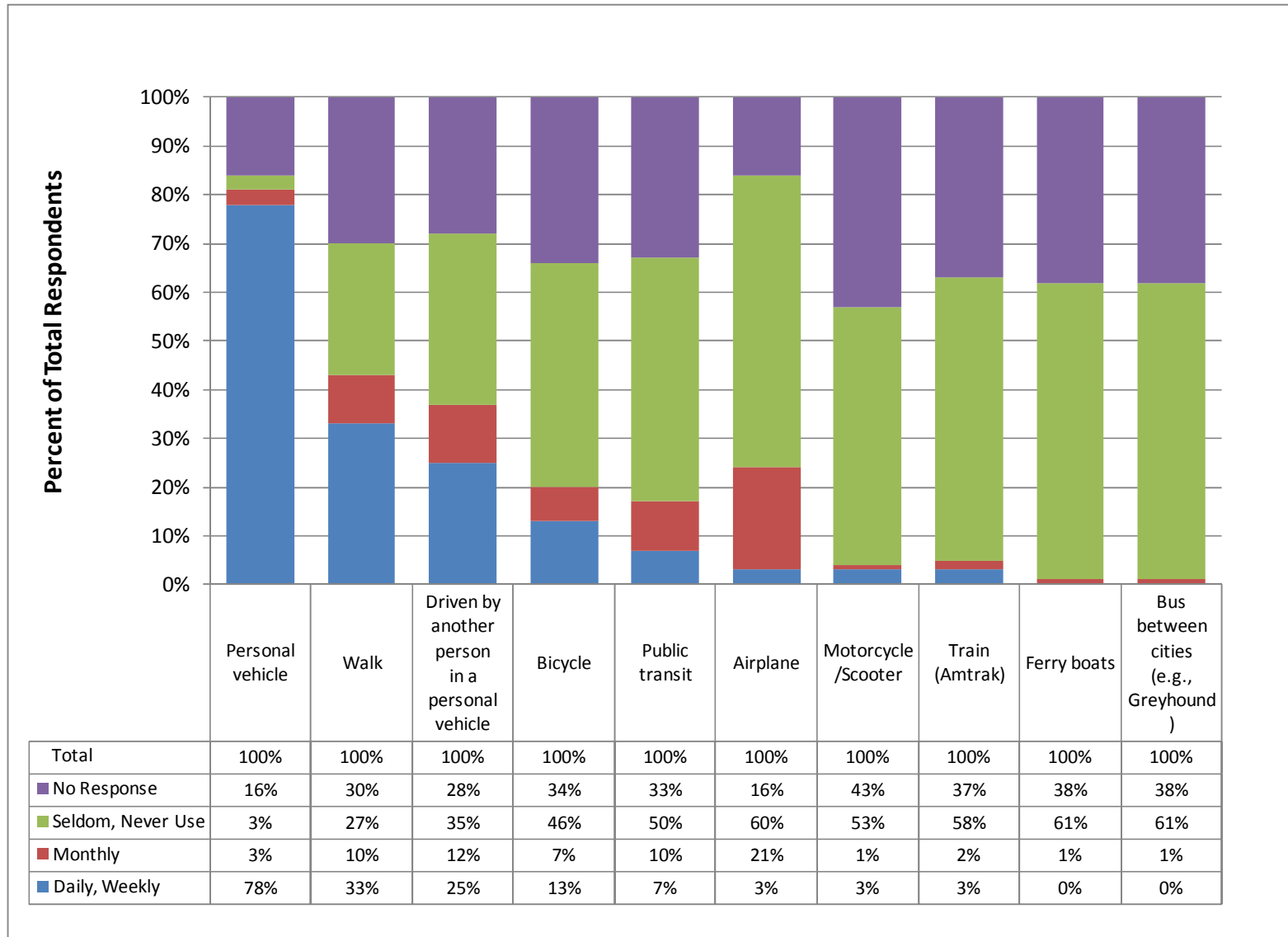

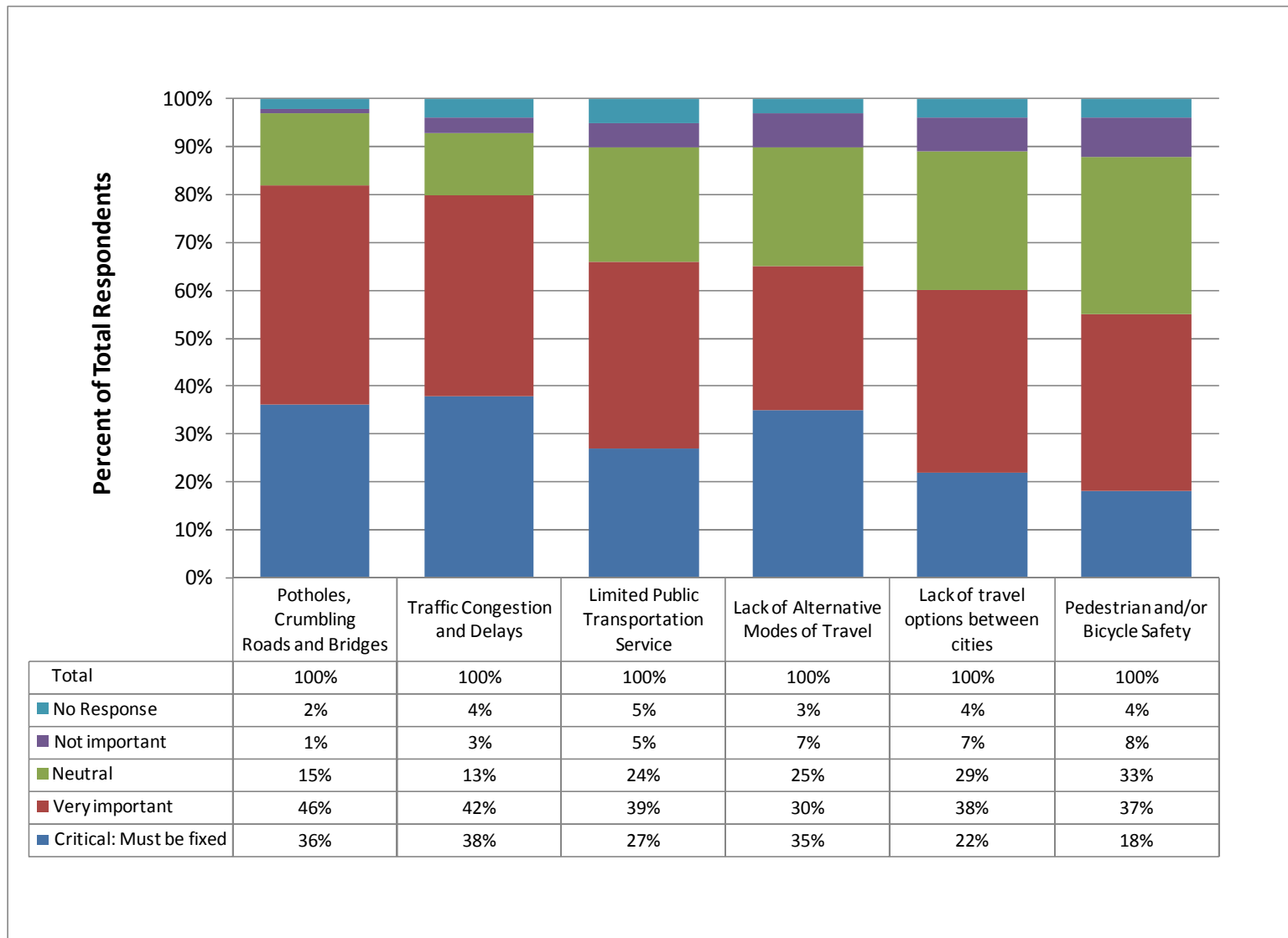
Question 3: How Do You Commute to Work/School?



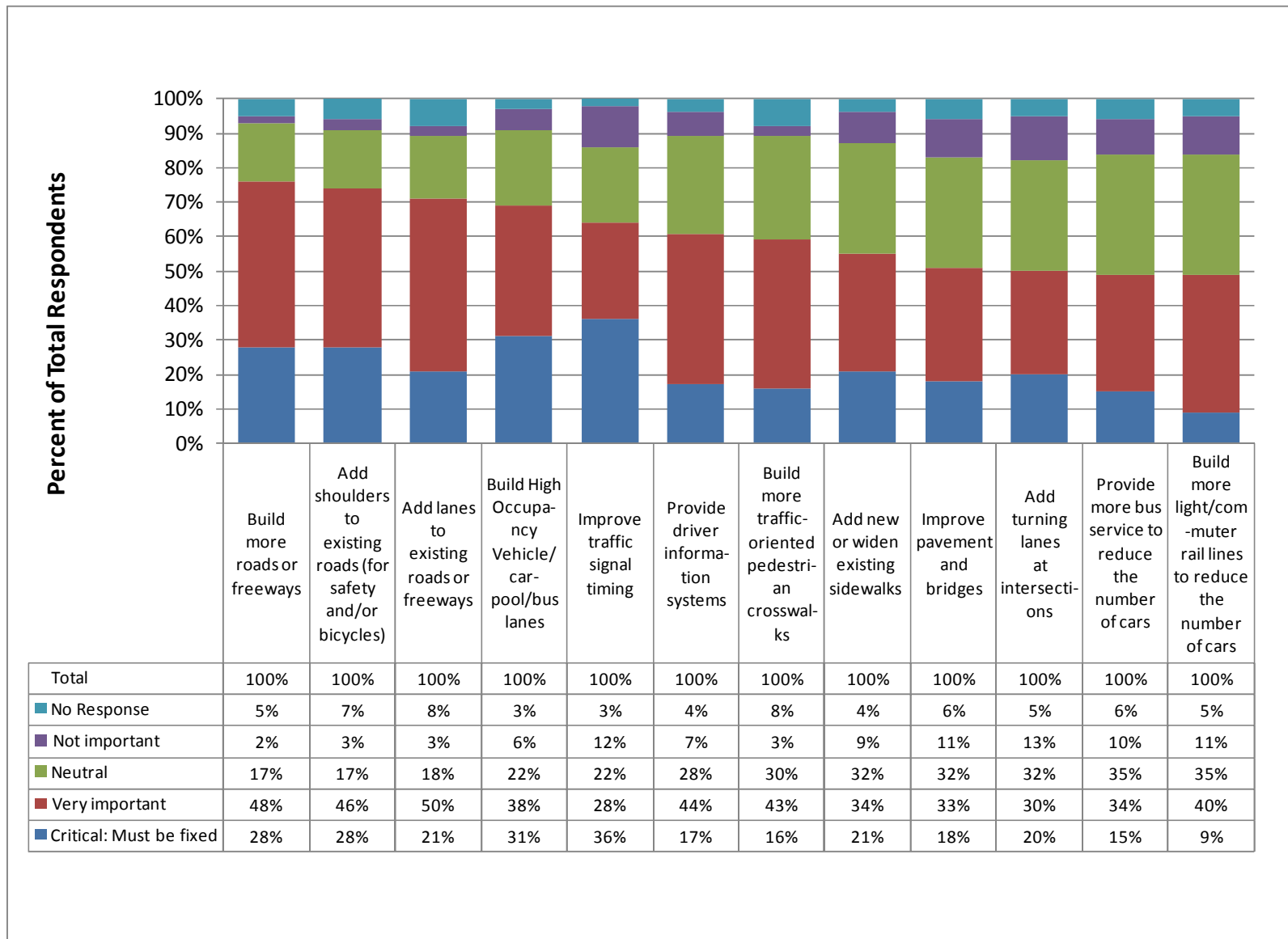
Question 4: What other ways do you travel in Texas?



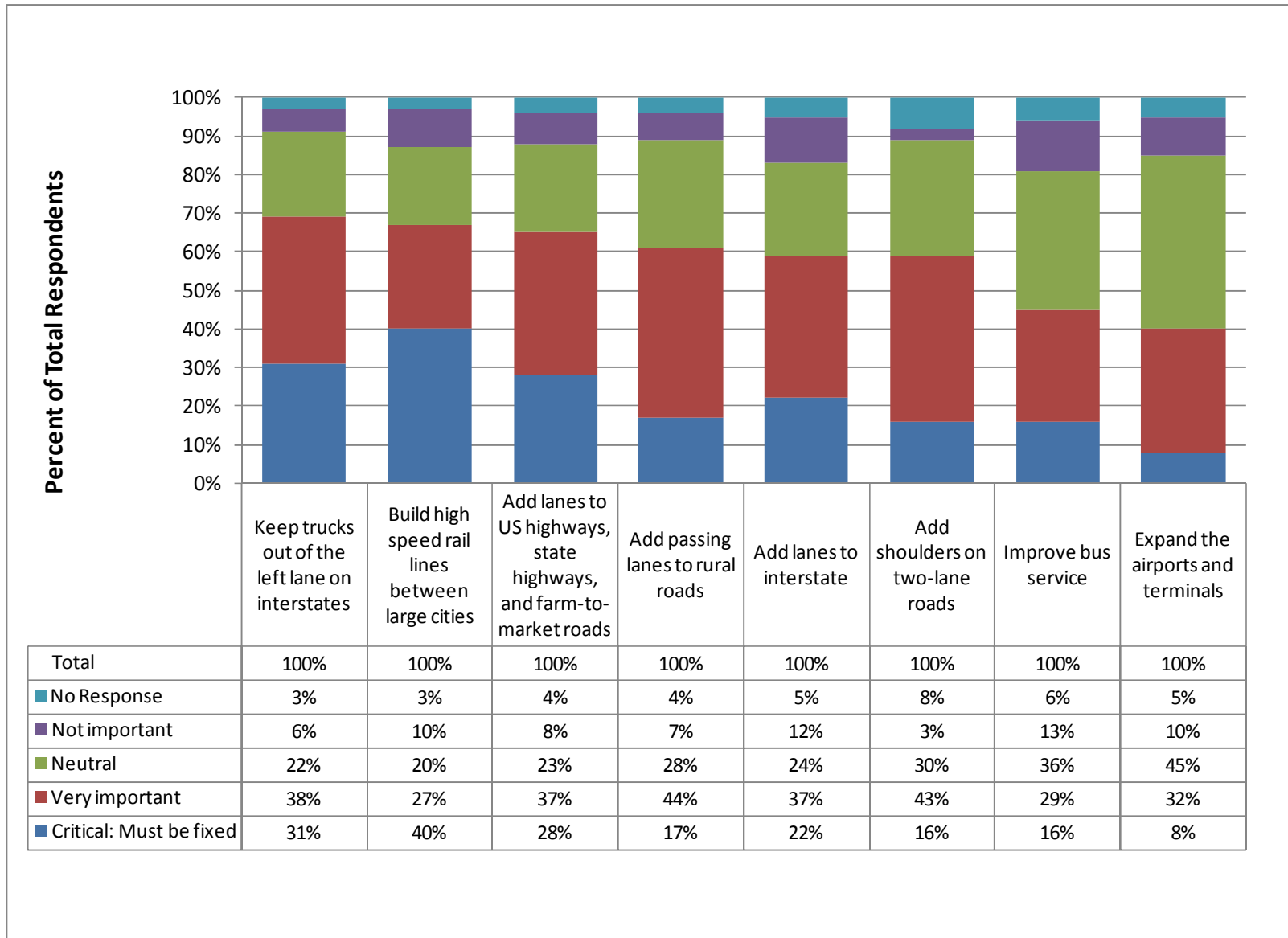
Question 5: How do you rate the following as Texas transportation problems?



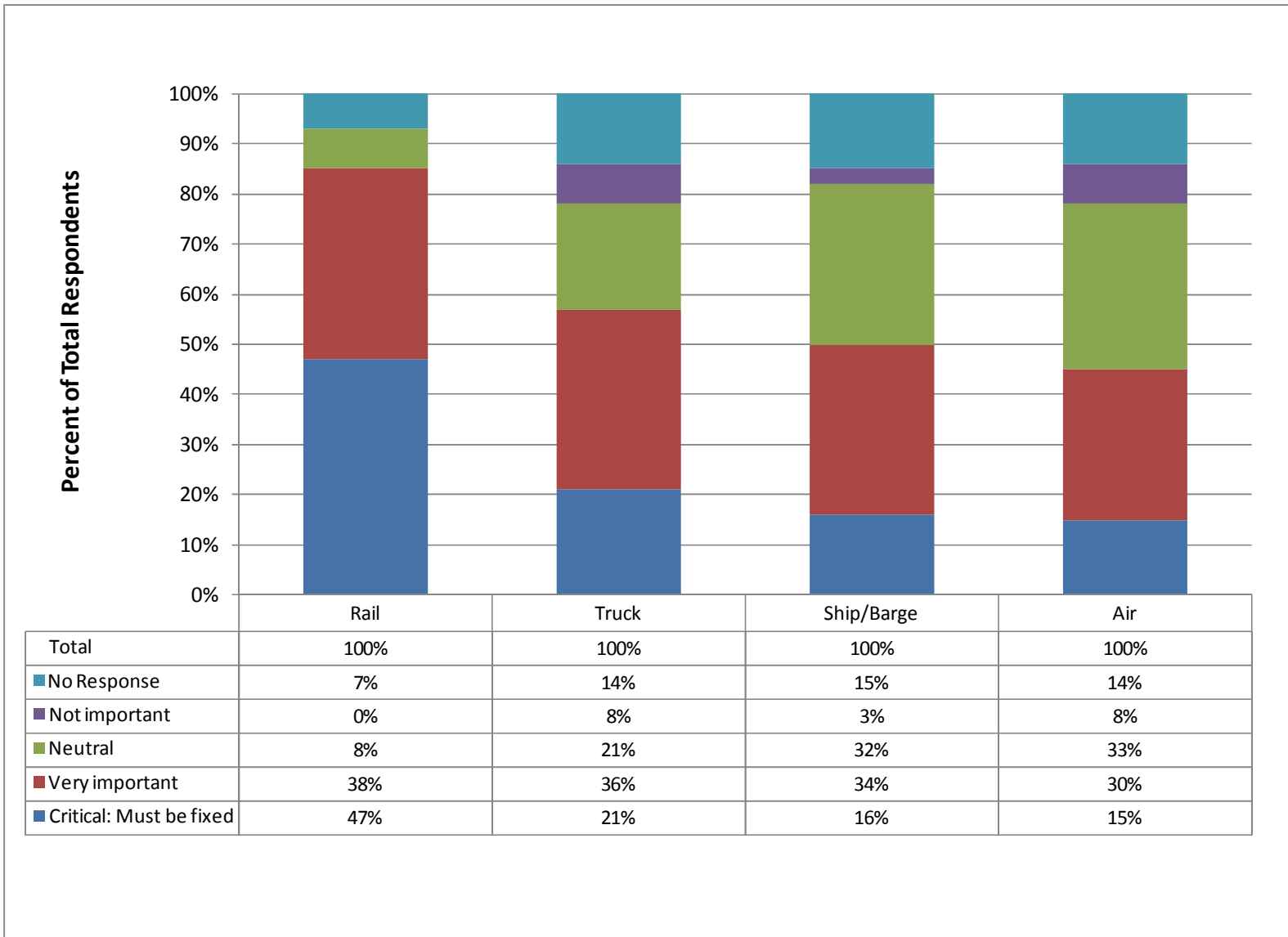
Question 6: How do you rate these potential solutions for improving Texas roads?
