Good evening. My name is Cheryl Flood and I am the Lufkin District Director of Transportation Planning and Development for the Texas Department of Transportation. Welcome to the public hearing for the February 2012 Quarterly Revision of the 2011-2014 Rural Transportation Improvement Program or the Rural TIP. This public hearing concerns 4 highway improvement projects and 1 transit project additions to the existing 2011- 2014 Rural TIP document. They are:

- 1. Resurface and widen Spur 339 in Angelina County for a continuous two-way left turn lane with curb & gutter section from LP 287 to LP 36. Funds for this project come through the Public Lands programs designated for Forest Highways in Texas. Scheduled for fiscal year 2013.
- 2. Provide additional paved surface width and a left turn lane at FM 276 on SH 87 in Sabine County from 0.2 Mile North of FM 276 to SH 21 in Milam. Funds for this project are also from the Public Lands Program designated for Forest Highways in Texas. Scheduled for fiscal year 2013.

- 3. Add a southbound frontage road and reconstruct main lanes on US 59 in San Jacinto County from just south of UPRR in Shepherd to just north of FM 2914, converting this section of US 59 to a controlled access facility. This project is programmed with Prop 12 Bond funds allocated to the Lufkin District. Scheduled for fiscal year 2013.
- 4. Widen FM 2609 from 2 lanes to 4 lanes from Raguet Street to North Street in Nacogdoches County. Scheduled for fiscal year 2014.
- 5. The transit project consists of \$300,000 in Federal Transit Administration funds, requiring a local match of \$75,000, for transporting military veterans from Lufkin to the VA Hospital in Houston, with a stop in Livingston. These funds are from a Congressional Earmark obtained by Senator John Cornyn in 2010.
