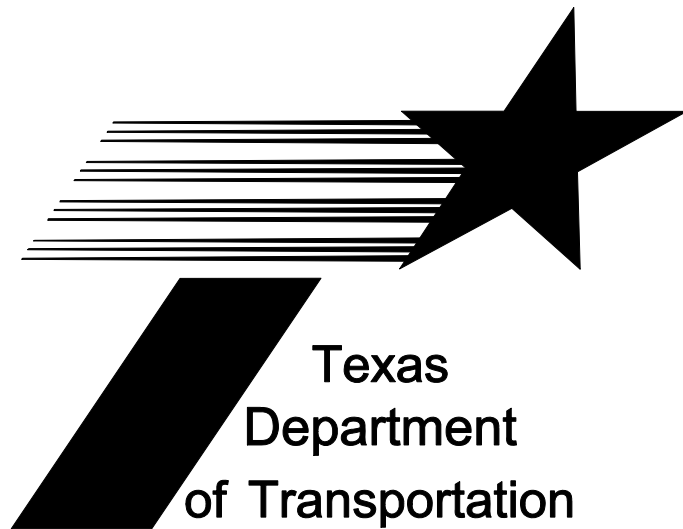

SUBJECT: Revision to FY 2008 and FY 2009 Transportation Improvement Program

We have recently discovered an error in the limits statement of two projects listed in the Transportation Improvement Program for FY 2008 and FY 2009. The subject projects are contiguous and are located within the San Angelo Metropolitan Planning Organization boundary and are therefore listed in the MPO's slate of projects. The corrections addressed by this revision are clerical in nature and do not affect any other feature of the two projects, including scope, funding and schedule, nor do they affect the originally intended project locations. We have updated the appropriate information in DCIS and have presented this information in a public meeting of the San Angelo MPO on October 11, 2007.
