



Public Meeting Notice 2013 Unified Transportation Program Revision

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an open-house style public meeting via WebEx to solicit public comments and input for revisions to the 2013 UTP, which covers FY 2013 through 2022.

The statewide public meeting will be held at **4:00 PM (CST) to 5:00 PM on Thursday, May 23, 2013.**

Unified Transportation Program

The UTP is a comprehensive ten-year plan for the development and construction of State of Texas transportation projects including roadways, aviation, public transportation, waterways and coastal waters, and rail projects and includes specific funding levels for each fiscal year.

Beginning promptly at 4:00 p.m., TxDOT staff will conduct a brief presentation via WebEx, on the purpose and revisions to the 2013 UTP. Additional information will be available for public viewing and TxDOT representatives will be on-hand to discuss the development process and answer questions. Comments can be made in person by attending a designated meeting location, by phone, or by typing in your question during the WebEx.
