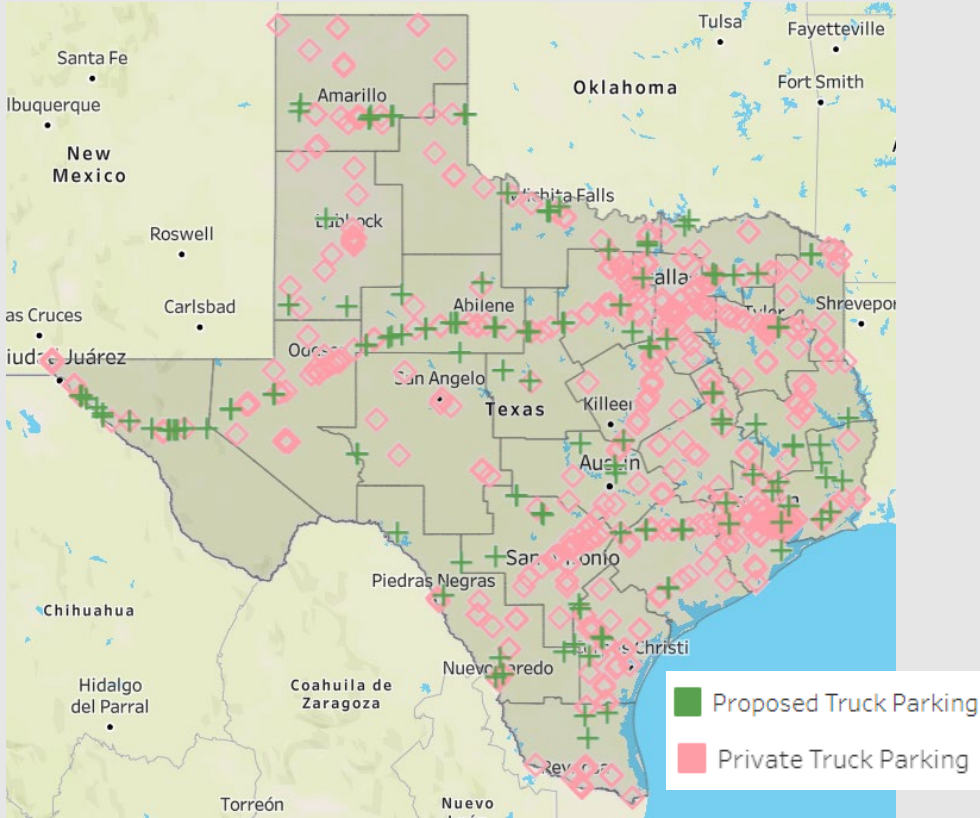

Public-Private Truck Parking



KEY FINDINGS

TxDOT provides less than 10% of all authorized truck parking in the state

TxDOT maintains **177 locations** with approximately **2,300 truck parking spaces**.

The **private sector** provides more than **90% of Texas truck parking capacity** with nearly **25,000 truck parking spaces**.

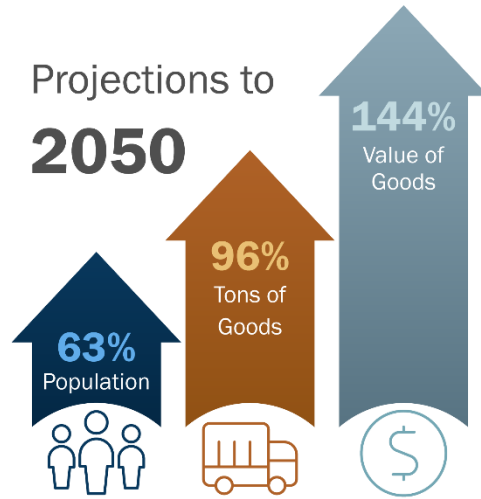
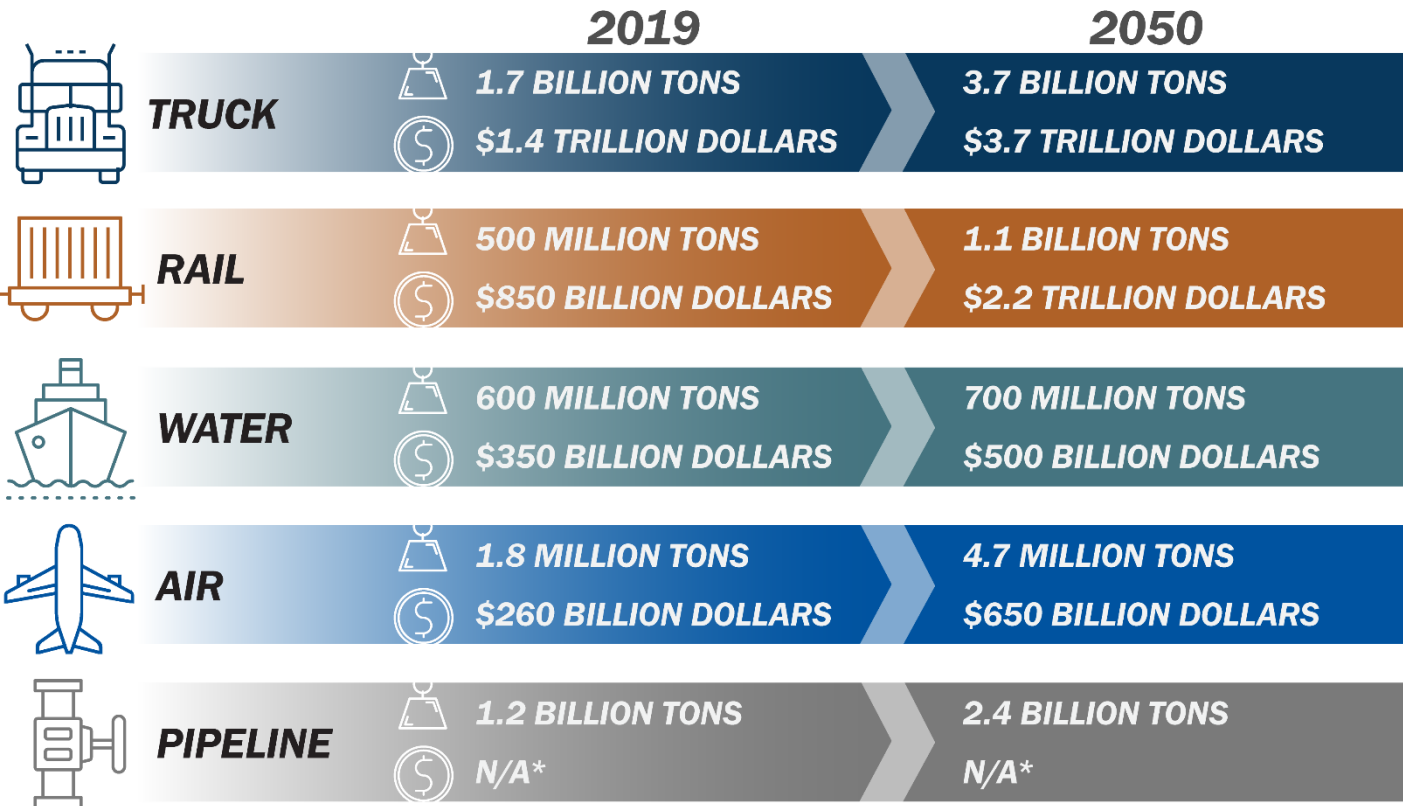

Summary of Freight Transportation Assets in Texas



Over **80,000 MILES** of TxDOT system roadways

- Over **23,000 MILES** on THFN
- **745 miles** of Critical Rural Freight Corridors
- **372 miles** of Critical Urban Freight Corridors



21 PORTS and the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway system

- **12 DEEP PORTS** | 9 on the TMFN
- **9 SHALLOW DRAFT PORTS** | 1 on the TMFN
- **379 miles of GIWW** | All on the TMFN



426,000 MILES of pipeline

- **59%** intrastate
- **41%** interstate



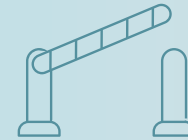
Over **10,539 miles** of railroads on the TMFN

- **3 Class I** railroads
- **55 Class III** (shortline) railroads

- **10 CARGO AIRPORTS** on the TMFN

- **15** commercial vehicle crossings

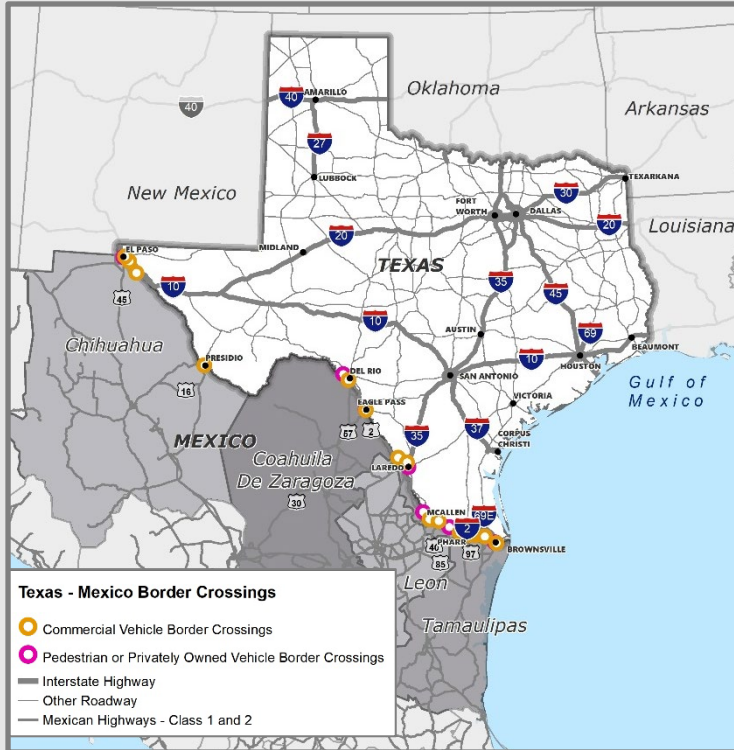
