FY 19 - FY 22 Rural Transportation Improvement Program

The Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public meeting on May 1, 2018 from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM at the Panhandle Regional Planning Commission Board Room, 415 W. 8th, Amarillo, TX 79105. The purpose of this meeting is to receive comments on the FY 2019-2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program for the Amarillo District. The district includes Dallam, Sherman, Hansford, Ochilree, Lipscomb, Hartley, Moore, Hutchinson, Roberts, Hemphill, Oldham, Potter, Carson, Gray, Deaf Smith, Randall and Armstrong Counties. The TIP is a mechanism used by TxDOT and FHWA to fund projects for the next four years and includes all federally funded projects. This meeting is being held pursuant to Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program.
