

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND AFFORDING AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A PUBLIC HEARING

The Atlanta District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT-ATL) will conduct a public meeting on Thursday, November 15, 2018. The meeting will begin at 4:30 p.m. and will be held at The Texas Department of Transportation Texarkana Area Office, 520 Sowell Lane Texarkana, Texas. The purpose of the meeting is to provide information regarding transportation projects and programs that might affect bicycle use of the state system within the Atlanta District. The Atlanta District is made up of Bowie, Camp, Cass, Harrison, Marion, Morris, Panola, Titus, and Upshur Counties.

The meeting will consist of an open house from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Exhibits pertaining to the existing state system and upcoming projects on the state system will be available.
