

AUSTIN AVENUE BRIDGES PROJECT



The City of Georgetown, in cooperation with the Texas Department of Transportation, has identified proposed improvements for Austin Avenue from Morrow to 2nd Streets including two bridges crossing the North and South Forks of the San Gabriel River.



PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Rehabilitate the existing bridges and maintain the railings
- Construct a new pedestrian bridge to the east
- Construct a 10-foot sidewalk on the east side of Austin Avenue and 6-foot sidewalk on the west side of Austin Avenue at the San Gabriel Village Boulevard and 2nd Street intersections
