

FM 969

IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FM 973 TO HUNTERS BEND ROAD

TRAVIS COUNTY AND TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHAT

Travis County, in conjunction with the Texas Department of Transportation, is proposing improvements to FM 969 between FM 973 and Hunters Bend Road, a distance of approximately 2 miles. The final project would upgrade the roadway to four travel lanes (two in each direction), include a continuous turn lane, new shoulders and a new continuous sidewalk on the south side of FM 969. The proposed 6-foot outside shoulders would accommodate cyclists.


WHY

Improving the safety for drivers and pedestrians along the roadway is the goal of this improvement project. As congestion has increased, so has the need for improvements. A new sidewalk would make it safer for pedestrians who also travel along the roadway.

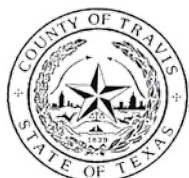
PROJECT COSTS

This project is being funded through a unique partnership between Travis County and the Texas Department of Transportation. A financing method called "pass thru financing" is being used to share the project costs between the two entities. Travis County will pay approximately \$8 million to design and build the improvements.
