

Pursuant to Transportation Code, §21.111, and Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, §30.209, the Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a virtual public hearing to receive comments from interested parties concerning approval of financial assistance at the following locations: Panola County, City of Cleveland, City of Clifton, City of Corsicana, City of Killeen, Hardin County, City of Midland, City of Mineral Wells, Port of San Antonio, Grayson County, Texas State Technical College at Waco, and City of Wharton.

The public hearing will be held on Friday, August 30, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. Any interested person may appear and offer comments, either orally or in writing; however, questioning of those making presentations will be reserved exclusively to the presiding officer as may be necessary to ensure a complete record. While any person with pertinent comments will be granted an opportunity to present them during the hearing, the presiding officer reserves the right to restrict testimony in terms of time and repetitive content. Organizations, associations, or groups are encouraged to present their commonly held views, and same or similar comments, through a representative member where possible.
